How our storage facilities work

DataHub provides several types of storage facilities, each with their own trade-off in costs, performance and data availability.

If you are **not working with identifiable human data** it only takes a few steps to get access to the appropriate storage systems. You can request access by following the next steps:

1. Fill out and submit this [Request new DataHub project](#) form
2. We will setup your environment accordingly and send you the link
3. Every data set uploaded to DataHub automatically gets assigned with a PID
